Qualifications to become a Councillor

A person is qualified to be elected and to be a councillor if he/she is

- a British, Commonwealth, Irish or European Union citizen and on the relevant day(that is, the day of nomination or election)
- he is 18 or over (qualifying age was reduced by section 17 of the 2006 Electoral Administration Act).

In addition, the person must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- 1. on the relevant day he must be on the electoral register for the community, or
- 2. during the whole of the twelve months before that day he has occupied as owner or tenant land or premises in the community, or
- 3. during the whole of the twelve months before that day his principal or only place ofwork has been in the community, or
- 4. during the whole of the twelve months before that day he has resided in the community or within three miles of it.
