2647 Minutes of the Meeting held on 14th November 2019

The minutes were read through alongside the Action Log. The Minutes were unanimously agreed as an accurate record and signed off.

2648 Matters Arising – inc Action Log

- Bench repairs – this has been postponed until the next meeting.
- Toilets – outside tap, new toilet roll holders etc is all in hand **Action Cllr Callan**
- Twinning of the toilets – twinning toilet.org. This requires a donation to support toilets in the 3rd World. A plaque is given in return £60 for two toilets. This could be a one-off or we could choose to do this annually as environmental support. It was unanimously agreed to go forward with this. **Action Cllr Hather and Clerk**
- Wye and Usk are happy to help out with the trees on the river, but landowners' permission is needed.
- Road near Cwm Deri. It was agreed that this should be monitored and reported on at the next meeting. **Action Cllr Callan**
- Permission given to pay for the new playground spinner when the Lottery Fund money comes in (£8040). We need to show it was funded by the lottery and the council in any promotion, and in a plaque for the playground itself. **Action Clerk**
- Bus shelter – keep it simple, ideal clear plan. We need to talk again to local people. Clerk to check out drop down seating to replace the bench. **Action Clerk**
- Dog Poo bins £75 each. Powys should empty them. One bin for the top of the path to the Lake and Spa and one near the Riverside Gardens. It was agreed to purchase two. **Action Clerk.**
- Cllrs Price and Wear are checking the playground weekly for insurance purposes (we need a record) and looking at when the bin needs emptying. **Action Cllrs Price and Wear**

2650 VE Day

The Clerk to set up a request to the churches, chapel, halls, Llanwrtyd Community Transport and Llanwrtyd Town council to either agree to work with, or to ensure events do not clash.

A post will need to be installed for a dog poo bin.
